This training objective is to inform employers supervisors and workers of the hazards and health risks associated with exposure to silica dust, the safe work procedures and their responsibilities for creating, implementing and maintaining a safe and healthy work environment and to meet the general requirements under the Occupational Health & Safety Act and Regulations and any other applicable governing agencies specific to silica dust exposure.
